Tuition Grant Scheme for International Students (Academic Year, AY2024)

Dear Student,

The Ministry of Education's Tuition Grant (TG) Scheme is to help defray the cost of full-time diploma courses at polytechnics for students.

As an International Student, you are eligible to apply for a TG upon successful enrolment into a polytechnic, provided you have not received TG previously to complete a course at the same or higher level of education. There is a limited number of TGs available for International Students, and these are awarded on a competitive basis based on merit.

To confirm eligibility, students must complete the TG Option Form on Republic Polytechnic's Online Enrolment Portal. Refer to the Enrolment Package for information on TG Scheme and submit an online application for TG at <https://tgonline.moe.gov.sg> from 16 May – 23 May 2024.

If your application is successful, the grant will be applied directly on the total amount due on your Student Bill at Republic Polytechnic. You will be required to seek and secure employment with a Singapore entity to serve the three-year bond upon graduation.

Unsuccessful applicants, or those who decided not to apply for TG, will pay the full tuition fees for their studies at Republic Polytechnic.

Two sureties are required to complete the signing of the TG Agreement.

- You are encouraged to get your immediate family to be your sureties;
- Your sureties may be of any nationality, be above 21 but below 65 years old and must not be undischarged bankrupts; and
- Your sureties must not be TG / scholarship recipients with outstanding obligations.
