Republic Polytechnic Celebrates Achievements Of Over 4,600 Graduates

First graduating cohort from the Diploma in Financial Technology and Diploma in Digital Design & Development

Singapore, 3 May 2023 – Republic Polytechnic (RP) today marked its 18th graduation ceremony, celebrating the achievements of more than 4,600 graduates who will be receiving their diplomas and specialist diplomas over 15 sessions. **Dr Maliki Osman, Second Minister for Education, graced the occasion as Guest-of-Honour.**

Contributing To Singapore's Industry Transformation

This year's ceremony will witness the first graduating cohort from the Diploma in Financial Technology (DFT) and Diploma in Digital Design & Development. Both courses aim to support Singapore's vision of becoming a Smart Nation and technological hub. The graduates from these courses will play a part in helping local industries automate and scale up technologically to remain competitive in the global market.

Mohamed Isa bin Mohamed Basir is among the DFT graduates who will be applying his skillsets to benefit local industries. During his internship at Oracle's NetSuite business unit, Mohamed Isa had the opportunity to work with cross-functional teams across the globe to improve the various technological systems and processes within the organisation. He also developed programmes and projects to automate manual repetitive tasks in a bid to increase productivity.

Mohamed Isa's performance impressed his company and lecturers, and he was selected to visit the Amazon Web Services office in Seoul to tap on the technological insights of industry leaders. Reflecting on his experiences and aspirations, Mohamed Isa said, "The pandemic has shown us the importance of tapping on emerging technologies to reinvent how we work and live. The opportunities in my course have also empowered me to use technology to solve wicked problems and benefit the community."

Discovering Passion And Purpose

Amongst the Class of 2023 is Kishen Suresh from the Diploma in Outdoor & Adventure Learning (DOAL). After completing his GCE 'O' levels, Kishen was unsure of his next steps and spent a year figuring it out. After much reflection, Kishen realised that his true passion was in organising camps and outdoor adventures. He set his sights on RP's DOAL course as it resonated with him. However, the pandemic struck just as he enrolled.

"As a hands-on learner, it was challenging adapting to online lessons at first. However, the tireless care and guidance provided by my lecturers reaffirmed my love for sports and the outdoors during my time in Republic Polytechnic. In fact, my course has helped me to find my calling as a physical education teacher. I now hope to inspire the next generation to become healthier and more passionate about sports and the outdoors", shared Kishen.

Today, Kishen is part of the more than 300 graduates from RP's School of Sports, Health and Leisure, who will be answering Singapore's call for trained manpower in the relevant industries.



Ms Jeanne Liew, RP's Principal & Chief Executive Officer, acknowledged the achievements of the graduating cohort, "As Singapore's youngest polytechnic, we have pushed the envelope in higher education through our holistic learning environment. Beyond the classroom, students are nurtured to realise their passion and potential, through increasing overseas internship opportunities to regional countries. They also get to deepen their skills and stretch their creativity through impactful real-world projects that add value to the industry.

Budding entrepreneurs can pursue their aspirations through our unique entrepreneurship ecosystem, which has since incubated over 50 startups across various industries. As this cohort joins our 66,000 strong alumni, I encourage them to continue learning and to acquire global perspectives while further developing the interpersonal and multidisciplinary skills that they have picked up in their diploma course."

To further support the transformation of local industries with a pipeline of skilled manpower, RP will be launching a total of seven SkillsFuture Career Transition Programme (SCTP) starting from June 2023. For a start, five part-time SCTPs ranging from three to six months will support mid-career individuals in acquiring new and relevant skills to enhance employability or transit to new job roles. These SCTPs will cover areas including digital marketing, supply chain management and digital accountancy.
