Tuition Grant Scheme for Singapore Permanent Residents (SPRs) (Academic Year, AY2026)

Dear Student,

The Ministry of Education's Tuition Grant (TG) Scheme aims to support students who wish to stay and work in Singapore after completing their full-time diploma courses at polytechnics. For eligible students who are committed to seek employment and work in a Singapore entity locally to serve a three-year bond obligation, the scheme will help to defray the cost of their education. It is essential that you gain a thorough understanding of the scheme requirements and obligations by watching this short video: <https://go.gov.sg/tg-info-video-rp> before applying.

As a SPR, you are eligible to apply for a TG upon successful enrolment into a polytechnic, provided you have not previously received TG to complete a course at the same or higher level of education.

To confirm eligibility, you must submit the TG Option form on Republic Polytechnic's Online Enrolment Portal. Refer to the Enrolment Package for information on TG Scheme and submit an online application for TG at <https://tgs.moe.gov.sg/> from 16 May – 30 May 2026.

If you are assessed to be eligible, you will be notified to complete the application. If your application for TG is successful, the grant will be applied directly to the total amount due on your Student Bill at Republic Polytechnic.

If your application is unsuccessful, or should you decide not to apply for TG, you will need to pay the full tuition fees for your studies at Republic Polytechnic.

Signing Of Tuition Grant Agreement

The signing of Tuition Grant Agreement for AY2026 will be done digitally. More details will be sent to you via email separately by your institution.

Important information on Sureties

Two sureties are required to complete the signing of the TG Agreement.

- You are encouraged to get your immediate family members to be your sureties;
- Your sureties may be of any nationality, be above 21 but below 65 years old and must not be undischarged bankrupts; and
- Your sureties must not be TG / scholarship recipients with outstanding bond obligation.
- Your sureties must not be a surety of another TG/ scholarship recipient who has failed to fulfil their bond obligation.
