ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should possess one of the following combinations of qualification and work experience:

- **O-Level:** At least three O-Level passes including English Language (Grade 1-7), any Science subject (Grade 1-6), and one other relevant subject (Grade 1-6), with at least one year of relevant work experience
- **Higher Nitec:** GPA \geq 2.0; OR GPA \geq 1.5 with at least one year of relevant work experience
- **Nitec:** GPA \geq 3.5; OR GPA \geq 3.0 with at least one year of relevant work experience
- **Higher Nitec in Technology/Services:** GPA \geq 2.0 with at least one year of relevant work experience
- **Nitec in Technology/Services:** GPA \geq 3.5 with at least one year of relevant work experience
- **Workforce Skills Qualification (WSQ):** Relevant WSQ Advanced Certificate (or higher), with at least one year of relevant work experience, Level 6 WSQ Workplace Literacy Statement of Attainment (SOA), and Workplace Numeracy SOA

If you do not meet the entry requirements, you may be considered for admission to the course based on evidence of at least two years of relevant working experience or supporting evidence of competency readiness. Suitable applicants who are shortlisted will have to go through an interview and/or entrance test. The polytechnic reserves the right to shortlist and admit applicants.
