ENTRY REQUIREMENT

SPECIALIST DIPLOMA

Applicants should possess a relevant local polytechnic diploma or degree in any discipline.

If you do not meet the entry requirements, you may be considered for admission to the course based on evidence of at least three years of relevant working experience or supporting evidence of competency readiness. For shortlisted applicants, you may have to go through an interview and/or entrance test.



WSPOSTDIP

Applicants (Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents) who want to pursue the course under WSPostDip must be either:

 Polytechnic graduates from relevant courses (within three years of their graduation date or completion of National Service) who are selected for hiring by WSPostDip-participating companies;

OR

• Current employees who have graduated from polytechnic for more than three years but within five years from date of graduation or completion of National Service

Admission will be reviewed and approved on a caseby-case basis.
